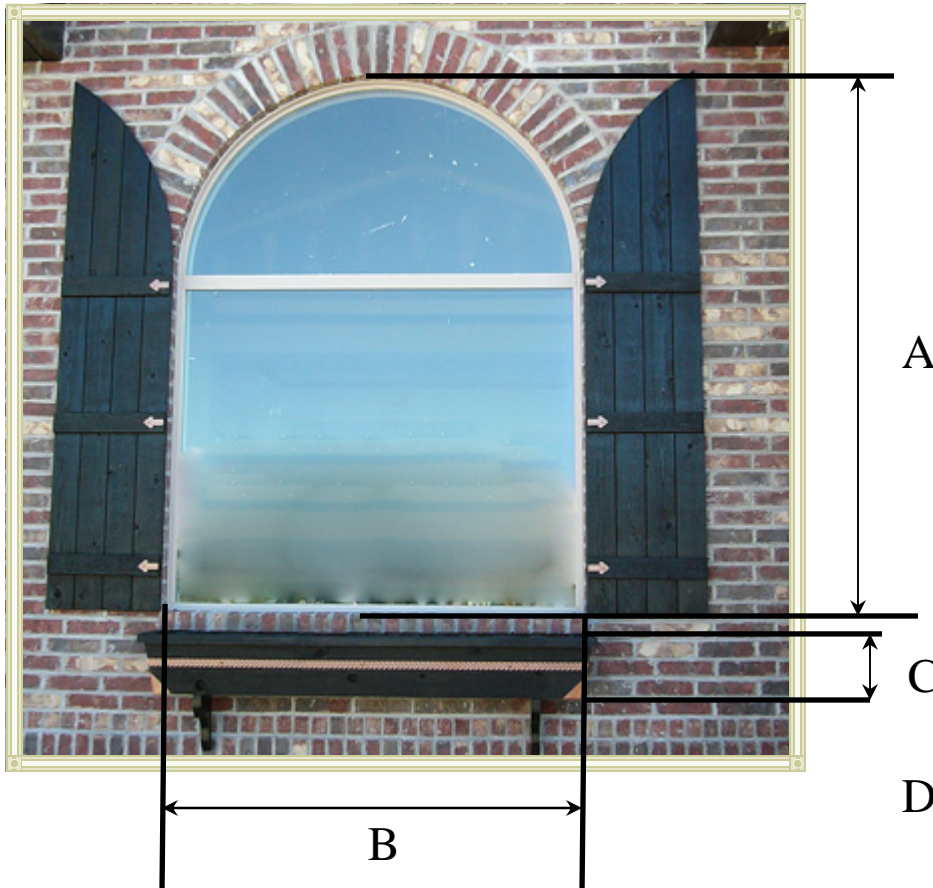


DETERMINING SHUTTER AND PLANTER DIMENSIONS



Determining your Shutter or Planter dimensions is easy. If you can use a tape measure getting the information is easy. Listed below are a few simple instructions to help guide you through the process.

D = Depth (see below)

1. Refer to the picture and provide the measurements for the areas outlined as “A”, “B”, “C” or “D”. A and B represent window height and width from edge to edge. See the **Select a Shutter Guide** for shutter arc-top selection and model details, use assigned number on the guide when ordering shutter style.
2. “C” represents planter height (our standard window planter boxes are 11” tall and ~9 1/2” deep and are designed to hold multiple standard nursery planters and are typically installed on windows 3’0 to 7’0 wide) Wider and smaller settings are determined using size ratio.
3. “D” represents “*desired*” distance from front edge of planter back to building it is attached to. Simply click on **contact us or Buy Now** and we’ll do the rest. For faster excellent service be sure to provide all of the requested information on the contact form, or simply call us from the number listed on the contact page.
